On behalf of the entire Peterson Staff, I would like to welcome everyone to the Peterson Family for the 2017-2018 school year. We look forward to working with parents in helping children become lifelong learners and strong citizens. This school year is filled with many exciting and unique educational and cultural activities that help develop a well rounded child. It is our goal to provide a safe, loving, and challenging school environment for all children. I want to emphasize to parents the importance of communication and involvement in your child's education.

This year we are recognizing student positive behaviors through our Positive Behavior Intervention support (PBIS) program. REGISTRATION FORMS FOR THE 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR

Every student must have a NEW registration form for the 2017-2018 school year. It is imperative that the school office be notified immediately of any change in address, home or office telephone number, or emergency information during the school year.



MEDICATIONS

If your child needs to take any type of medication at school (prescription or over the counter), the parent must come into the school office to fill out a **Medication Permission Form**. This allows the school to administer medication to your child. The medication must be in the original container/box with all the directions for usage.

If you would like your child to self administer over the counter medication, you must fill out a **Self-Medication Permission Form** and **receive permission from the principal** for your child to do so. He/She may only bring one day's worth of medication to school each day.

If you want your child to self administer **prescription medication**, you must fill out a permission form, have **permission from the medical provider (on the label)**, **AND receive permission from the principal**. All prescription medication must be in the original container with a current prescription label.

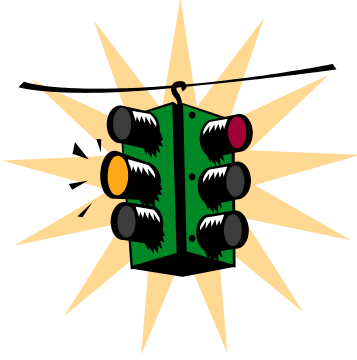

● CAFETERIA ●

Peterson School has free breakfasts and lunches for all enrolled students through the Community Eligibility Provision of the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. If you wish, you may put money on your child's account for extra milks. Otherwise, everything is free for students. Adults who wish to eat a meal must pay in the office **before** eating either breakfast or lunch.

Adult breakfast -	\$2.40
Adult lunch -	\$3.75
Child breakfast -	\$1.65
Child lunch -	\$2.45
Milk only or extra milk -	\$0.50



CHILD SAFETY

KCSD policy requires written notes if your child is changing the way he/she is going home. For example, if your child normally walks, but is to ride a bus one day after school, we need to have a note signed by the parent/guardian. Please remember - the only people who may pick up your child/children are the adults who are listed on the registration form.

VISITING PETERSON SCHOOL

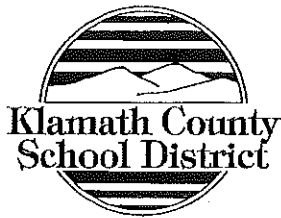
Parents are always welcome to visit our school. For the safety of our students, **ALL VISITORS MUST SIGN IN AT THE OFFICE** when they enter the building and obtain and wear a VISITOR'S PASS. **Staff will stop any visitor not wearing a badge.** If you have lunch with your child/children, you need to come into the office **FIRST** to sign in, get a pass, and pay for your lunch. An adult lunch is \$3.75. Thank you. ☺



BIRTHDAYS

We celebrate birthdays school wide during our weekly assembly. We call each student out that has a birthday that week and sing to them. Students who do not wish to participate in this do not have to do so.

We will no longer have birthday parties in the classrooms, so please do not bring any food or materials to the school. Thank you.



GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE ILL STUDENT

Parents/Guardians,

In order to maintain a healthy environment for your child and all students the following guidelines have been put into place.

Some students have medical conditions that can become life-threatening when exposed to measles, chicken pox/shingles, Fifth disease, rubella, and hepatitis. If your child is diagnosed during the school year with any of these diseases, please call the school immediately.

Conditions that require exclusion from school until either diagnosed by a health professional or the child has recovered include:

- Fever greater than 100.5 with or without other symptoms;
- Vomiting;
- Stiff neck or headache with fever;
- **Any** rash with or without fever;
- Unusual behavior change, such as irritability, lethargy, or somnolence;
- Jaundice (yellow color to skin or eyes);
- Diarrhea (3 watery or loose stools in one day with or without fever);
- Skin lesions that are "weepy" (fluid or pus-filled);
- Colored drainage from ears;
- Brown/green drainage from nose with fever of greater than 100.5;
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath; serious, sustained cough;
- Symptoms or complaints that prevent the student from participating in his/her usual school activities, such as persistent cough, with or without the presence of fever, or
- Student requires more care than the school staff can safely provide.

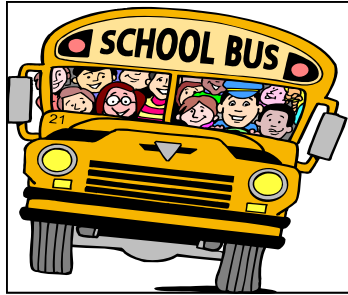


CAFETERIA NEWS!!!
