Interns with the Visitor Services division work hard to ensure the future of conservation by connecting people with nature through customer service; Interpretation and resource projects. Work Description:

- Provide customer service in the Visitor Center
- Assist staff with resource projects and general maintenance
- Work with the refuge education staff to prepare and conduct on- and off-site wildlife-dependent recreation opportunities such as archery, canoeing, and wildlife observation, for a variety of audiences

Requirements:

- A positive attitude
- Have the ability to communicate well with visitors and staff both orally and in writing
- Requires office and outdoor work. The position involves physical exertion such as walking over wet, rough, and uneven terrain, extreme temperatures and exposure to biting insects
- Requires schedule flexibility including weekends
