Smarter Balanced Statewide Assessments



Brixner 7th and 8th grade students have been taking the Smarter Balanced state-wide assessments. Science and English Language Arts testing has been completed. They are now starting the Smarter Balanced Math testing. **It is extremely important that your child is not absent during testing.** Please make sure your child is getting a good night's rest and a healthy breakfast at home or at school during testing. The state-wide tests are used to measure how Brixner students are doing compared with other schools and districts. They also are used to determine how the individual student is progressing toward meeting grade-level standards. Students' performance is increasingly important as these assessments are **now part of graduation requirements** and students need to be at grade-level performance to stay on track for graduation. Please encourage your child to do their very best.
