

Positive Hallway Sweep

(Tardiness)

The **Positive Hallway Sweep** is in place to remind and encourage punctual and prepared school behaviors. Tardiness to class disrupts the learning environment.

- ◆ Staff will be in hallways and classroom doors during passing time.
- ◆ Once the bell rings, teachers will close their door and begin class.
- ◆ A student is tardy once the classroom door has been closed.
- ◆ Tardy students will go, or be escorted by the Sweep Team, to the office for a Tardy Pass.
- ◆ The Tardy Pass is the student's ticket into class.
- ◆ **NO HALL PASSES** will be allowed the first 10 minutes of class.

Students late to school in the morning, need to be accompanied by a parent/guardian to check in at the office. They may also be admitted with a note or phone call by a parent/guardian.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Be on time to every class.
2. Enter the classroom safely and respectfully.
3. Be prepared and bring all materials for class.
4. If tardy, do not argue, go or be swept to the office for a Tardy Pass.
5. Show your tardy pass to the teacher.

Consequences are for total Unexcused Tardies in a 6-week grading period, **NOT** per class period.

Tardy 1–3 Lunch Detention – No Referral

Tardy 4 Lunch Detention – w/ Referral

Tardy 5 Wed. School – w/ Referral
Contact Home

Tardy 6+ May involve further progressive consequences such as In or Out-of-School Suspension.

Lunch Detentions will be served the following day.
