

Klamath County School District Restraint and Seclusion Incidents Report

23-24 School Year

1. Total number of incidents involving restraint: 123
2. Total number of incidents involving seclusion: 147

Each time a student is placed in restraint or seclusion, the team involved debriefs on said incident to problem-solve and anticipate future safety concerns. This debrief involves reviewing the student's Functional Behavior Assessment, Behavior Intervention Plan, Safety Plan, and/or accommodation behavior supports to ensure fidelity of implementation. If there are multiple restraints or seclusions and the student does not have a current Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA) or Behavior Intervention Plan, the team will meet to determine if an FBA should be conducted. If there are repeated instances of restraint in a short time frame, the team may call a meeting to determine if the student's needs or situation has changed and to identify new strategies to reduce the need for restraint or seclusion.

8. Total number of restraint or seclusion incidents carried out by untrained individuals: 0
9. Demographic Characteristics of all students upon whom restraint or seclusion was imposed:
 - 24% Female
 - 76% Male
 - 13% Hispanic*
 - 85% Non-Hispanic*
 - 13% Native American/Alaska Native*
 - 0% Asian*
 - 0.5% Black*
 - 84% White*
 - 0% Pacific Islander*

10. Total number of rooms available for use by the district and a description of the dimensions and design of the rooms:

KCSD has four (4) rooms available for use by the district for seclusion. Each room is at least 64 square feet in size with at least one wall being 8ft or longer. Each of the rooms have visibility through the door and each of the rooms are equipped with safety padding.
