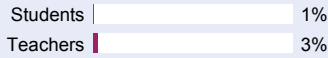

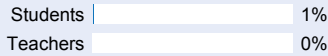

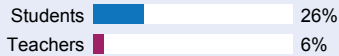

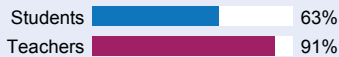

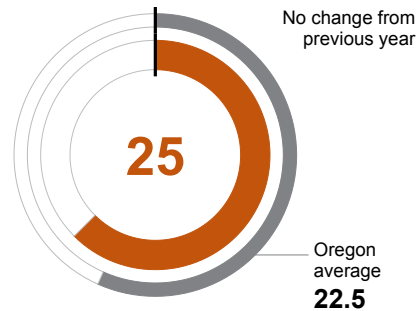

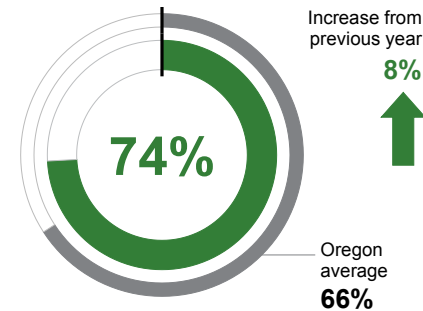
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

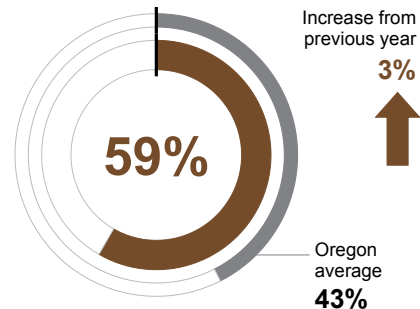
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

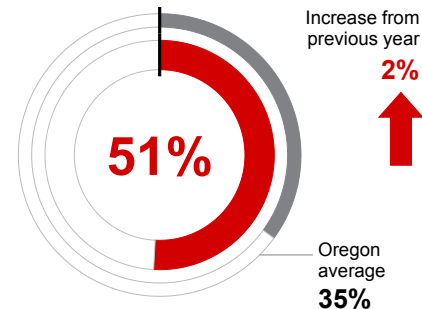
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



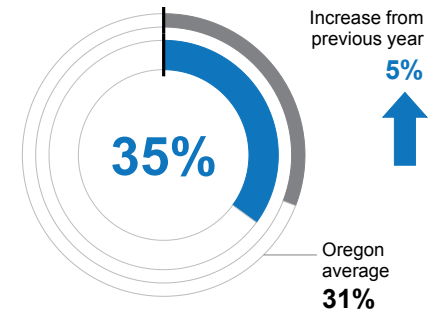
MATHEMATICS

School Goals

Our focus is to maintain/increase our Reading and Math scores. In addition to classroom instruction for support, we also promote regular attendance and positive behavior. Research shows that these two elements are a significant contributing factor for student's success both academically and developmentally. Our classrooms discuss a character trait each week and we provide time for students to use 'table talk' to work through social dilemmas they may face. We have developed small group reading to target individual student needs. We meet them where they are and help them grow.
