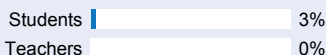

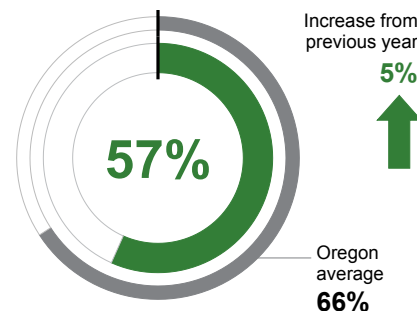
CLASS SIZE

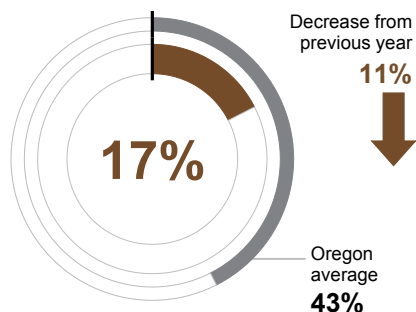

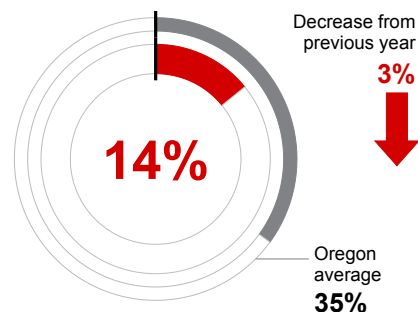

expectations.



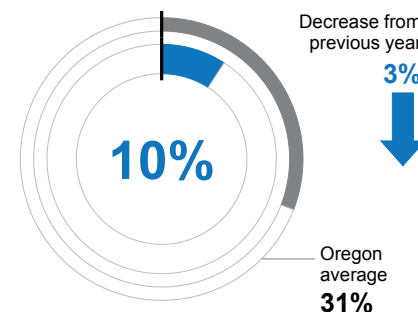
MATHEMATICS

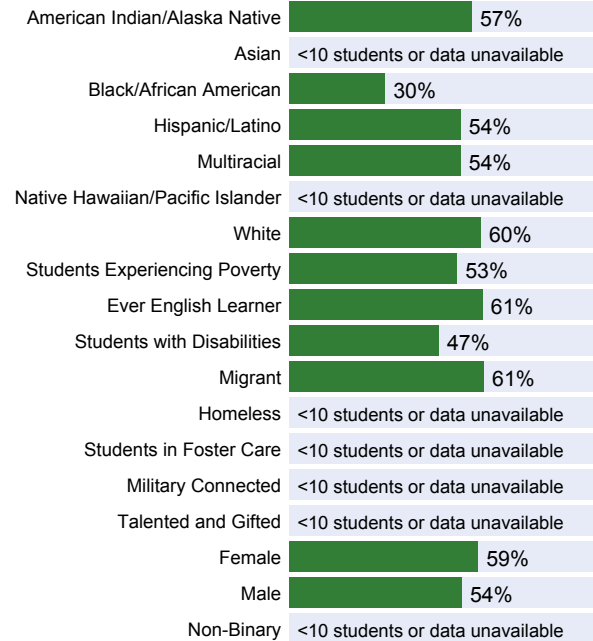

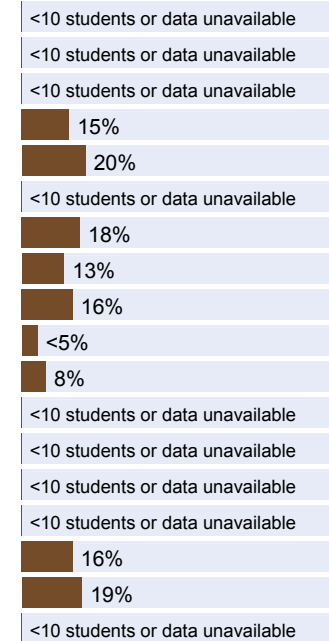

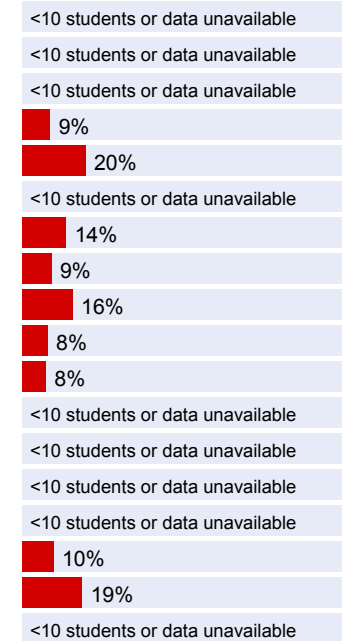
