

KLAMATH COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS

The following are the scholarships offered to Klamath County 4-H members through the Klamath County Leaders Association. NOTE NOT ALL SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE ALL YEARS AND AWARD AMOUNTS VARY:

Matthew Hubbard Memorial Scholarship	Livestock
Dog Scholarship.....	Dog (4 years)
Michael Howard Memorial & Wild Horse Scholarship	Horse
Robert Burleigh Jr. Memorial 4-H Scholarship	Sheep, Beef, Swine (2+ years)
Home Economics/Expressive Arts Scholarship	Non-Animal
Small Animal Scholarship	Cavies, Poultry, Rabbits

General Scholarship Criteria:

Eligibility:

1. Graduating high school senior enrolled in 4-H. Some scholarships require a minimum number of years in 4-H to be eligible.
2. Most scholarships require participation in a particular project area during the Klamath County Fair.
3. Applicants need to be planning to further his or her education in a university, college, trade, or vocational school.

Awards:

1. The scholarship committee based upon account balance for the particular year will determine amounts and number of recipients.
2. Payment of scholarships will be made directly to the school of the recipient's choice but not paid until Winter or Spring Term. Must have a successful first term.

General Scholarship Procedure:

1. Scholarship applicants only need to complete one general application.
2. Please check all the scholarships that you are eligible for and wish to apply.
3. All applications and related support materials need to be delivered to the Klamath County Extension Office on **Monday, May 19th by 5:00 PM.**

Applicants Need To Provide:

- a. 4-H Record Book, including all project records and 4-H Stories for current and previous years and up-to-date 4-H Resume.
- b. An official high school transcript that includes seven semesters. A copy of the eighth-semester transcript will be due upon graduation before funds are disbursed. Home school graduates should provide appropriate course verification material.
- c. Two Recommendations: A letter of recommendation from their 4-H leader for each project area in which they are applying and one letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
- d. An essay answering one of the following questions.

1) How has 4-H helped you determine your future plans?

2) Why have you stayed in 4-H through high school when so many do not?

3) What is your most memorable moment involving 4-H (humorous, challenging, impactful, rewarding, etc.)?

Interviews:

1. Applicants may be called for interviews.
